REVISED POLICY ON POLICE CLEARANCE REQUIREMENTS

Your attention is drawn on the above subject.

Effective immediately, the policy on police clearance is revised as follows: Henceforth, police clearance will no longer be required for internal staff movements for both horizontal and vertical mobility within MDAs.

However, note that Police Clearance still remains mandatory for all new recruits into an MDA.

Consequentially, PSO Order 16 (b) is amended accordingly.

Justification:

The objective of this revision is to provide greater flexibility within MDAs, while maintaining the necessary security measures. It is at the discretion of each MDA to decide on the requirement for police clearance for internal movements, thus allowing for a more tailored approach to security, considering the specific needs and circumstances of each MDA. Moreover, being cognisant of the different roles within MDAs may have varying levels of

sensitivity and security requirements., This revision of policy empowers MDAs to make informed decisions on the basis of their operational needs.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in the implementation of this revision to streamline processes to ensure the security and integrity of our workforce.
