Subject: Change of Title for Designated Minister

Following the Cabinet's approval on 8th August 2024, and the subsequent approval by the National Assembly on 2nd October 2024, we wish to inform you that the Eleventh Amendment to the Constitution of Seychelles has come into effect upon its publication in the Official Gazette on 28th October 2024.

This amendment involves the substitution of the title "**Designated Minister**" with "**Principal Minister**" across all relevant provisions within the Constitution of Seychelles.

Key Points to Note:

1. The title "Principal Minister" now replaces "Designated Minister" in the Constitution.
2. This change is effective immediately.
3. All relevant documents, reports, and communications must reflect the updated terminology.
4. Please ensure that references to "Designated Minister" are amended to "Principal Minister" in official records and all future communications.



This amendment represents a significant update in constitutional terminology, and all public service entities are required to adhere to this change.
