

# SCHEME OF SERVICE: INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY CADRE

## Systems Support

### 1. BACKGROUND

---

This Scheme of Service is designed for employees working for public sector involved in:

#### 1. **Technical Support:**

- Provide helpdesk support for hardware, software, and network issues.
- Troubleshoot and resolve technical problems for public service employees and, in some cases, the public.
- Assist users with technical queries and training on software applications.

#### 2. **Network Administration:**

- Manage and maintain local area networks (LAN), wide area networks (WAN), and internet connections.
- Ensure network security and performance through monitoring and maintenance.
- Implement and manage VPNs and other remote access solutions.

#### 3. **System Administration:**

- Install, configure, and maintain servers and operating systems.
- Monitor system performance and ensure system availability and reliability.
- Manage backups, disaster recovery plans, and data integrity.

#### 4. **Cyber security:**

- Protect public service systems and data from cyber threats and attacks.
- Implement and enforce security policies and procedures.
- Conduct regular security audits and vulnerability assessments.

#### 5. **Database Management:**

- Design, implement, and manage databases to store public service data.
- Ensure data accuracy, integrity, and security.
- Perform data backups and recovery operations.

#### 6. **Software Development and Maintenance:**

- Develop and maintain custom software applications to meet the specific needs of public service departments.
- Perform regular updates and upgrades to existing software systems.
- Collaborate with users to gather requirements and provide technical solutions.

#### 7. **Project Management:**

- Plan and manage IT projects, ensuring they are completed on time and within budget.
- Coordinate with other departments and stakeholders to implement technology solutions.
- Oversee the deployment of new technologies and systems.

#### 8. **Policy Implementation and Compliance:**

- Ensure compliance with government regulations and standards related to IT.
- Develop and implement IT policies and procedures.
- Educate staff on best practices and policies regarding technology use.

## 9. Procurement and Asset Management:

- Assist in the procurement of IT equipment and software.
- Maintain an inventory of IT assets and manage lifecycle processes.
- Evaluate and recommend new technology solutions to improve public service delivery.

## 10. User Training and Support:

- Conduct training sessions for public service employees on new technologies and systems.
- Create user manuals and documentation to assist staff in using IT resources effectively.
- Promote digital literacy among public service employees.

With the Department of Information Communication Technology as the Authority responsible for Information Technology for the Government, it hence holds the mandate to set operational and procedural standards throughout the structure. (PSO Order 323)

The Scheme provides for:

1. A clearly defined career structure to attract and retain suitably qualified and competent employees in the technical aspects of this profession;
2. A well-defined job description with clear delineation of duties and responsibilities at all levels within the career structure to enable such employees to understand the requirements and demands of the job;
3. Standards for recruitment, training and advancement within the career structure on to the basis of qualifications, merit and ability as reflected in work performance and results.

### 1. Inducement Allowance

An Inducement allowance at the following rates (inclusive of tax) will be paid to employees in this cadre as a further incentive to retain them in the Public Sector.

**Note:** Inducement allowances indicated above are a maximum and the percentage of their disbursement is subject to performance and qualifications, and it is at the discretion of the accounting Officer. The Inducement allowance also covers overtime work undertaken where the exigencies of the service so required.

### 2. On Call Allowance

Due to the vital importance of the different systems such as health, immigration, customs etc. that operate on a 24/7 basis there is a need for staff to remain on call and available so as to attend to emergencies.

Depending on the exigency of service, on call allowance will be paid at the rate of 5% of the basic salary to staff who have to be available after normal working hours throughout a month. Call outs are considered as overtime which is already covered under inducement allowance.

## 5. PROVISIONS OF POSTS

---

A Scheme of Service does not in itself constitute authority for creation or upgrading of posts. Any new post required under the new Scheme of Service must be approved in accordance with normal established procedures.

## 6. IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SCHEME

---

The revised Scheme of Service will become operational with effect on the 1<sup>st</sup> of July 2024. On implementation professionals of this cadre in the employment of the Government, will abide by the Scheme.

The initial scheme was approved on the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2018-and revised as follows:

- Revision of salary in line with salary table 2023 1st April 2023
- Revision of Inducement Allowance 1<sup>st</sup> July 2024
